Any time after 8.55am will be recorded as late on the register.

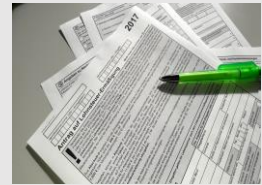
WRAPAROUND AND AFTERSCHOOL CLUBS
